Calf Housing Disinfectants

We now stock both Cyclex which is highly effective against endoparasites such as cryptosporidium parvum, coccidiosis and bacterial agents (e.g. Salmonella) and viruses. Appropriate disinfectants when used correctly can reduce infection pressure in animal housing.

Skin Disease/Skin Issues

We always see a peak in outbreaks of skin disease in cattle throughout the winter months. Whilst some cattle will develop characteristic lesions making diagnosis easy there are other cases where lesions caused by different diseases can look very similar. If you are unsure as to what is causing skin disease in your cattle then please contact the surgery and speak to any of the farm vets.

Rotavac Corona Vaccine

Rotavac Corona is the only vaccine that protects against rotavirus, coronavirus and E.coli in one shot. Cattle should be vaccinated with a 2ml dose in the muscle 3-12 weeks before calving. For more information or to place your order, please phone the office.

Heptavac P Plus

Heptavac P Plus can be used in pregnant ewes as an aid in control of problems such as lamb dysentery and tetanus. Ewes should be vaccinated 4-6 weeks pre-lambing. For more information on vaccination programs, please phone the office.

Liquid Gold

Liquid Gold for sheep contains a range of chelated minerals and vitamins formulated to ensure that ewes receive the correct balance of micronutrients that are easily absorbed. Liquid Gold can be administered 4-6 weeks pre lambing with the benefits of; more vigorous lambs, less retained cleansings and improved growth rates. Liquid Gold can also be given to lambs from one month onwards to boost live weight gains.

Ewe Boost

Ewe Boost is a super therapy that can be given to treat twin lamb. It is also useful for ewes that are off form.
